

Statistics for Institute Campaign

1. If all participants (not including the tutor) are from the same cluster, the study circle goes to that cluster. The locality is decided by the person providing the data. It can be the locality of one or more of the participants.
2. If a majority of the participants (not including the tutor) come from the same cluster, the study circle goes to that cluster. The locality is decided by the person providing the data. It can be the locality of one or more of the participants.
3. If there is no clear majority of participants, then the study circle goes to the milestone 1 cluster if there is one. If not, then it goes to the milestone 2 cluster. If not, then it goes to the milestone 3 cluster. The operating principle is that in each category, it goes to the cluster that needs it most. Contact Farzaneh or Marie if there are questions.
4. In any case listed above, the study circle never goes to another region. If there are participants from another region, do not count them when determining the majority, and then apply the process as above.
5. Devotional gatherings connected to study circles have data entered the same as any other devotional gathering. In other words, a host is identified, and the locality assigned is the locality of the host. The number of participants is recorded. It is possible that the host of the devotional might cause the locality to be different from the locality of the study circle. For example, the host of the devotional might be the tutor. This is ok. They are counted as separate activities, and they do not have to match.

First milestone clusters: Litchfield, Northern Catskills, Scranton, Altoona/State College, Jamestown/Olean, Northern NY, South Jersey, Berkshire, Warren, Williamsport

Third milestone clusters: New York City, Boston, Rochester, Long Island, Philadelphia
